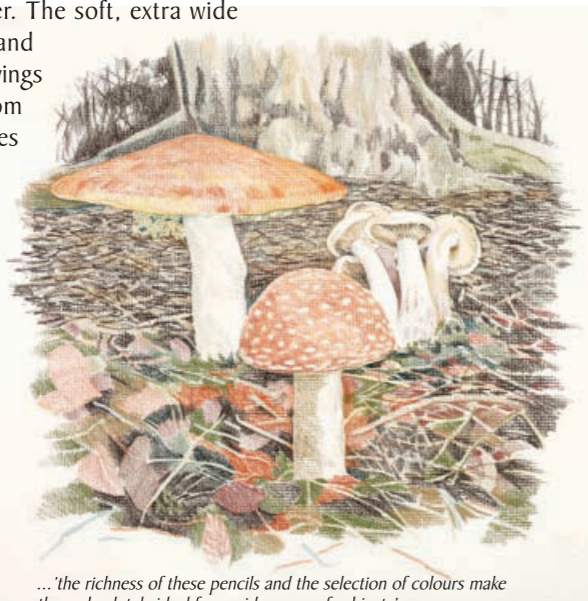

The thick, waxy consistency of Derwent Drawing makes it easy to apply and produces a rich, velvety finish on the paper. The soft, extra wide 5mm strip is ideal for blending and encourages loose, expressive drawings with subtle tonal transitions. From sweeping landscapes and seascapes to detailed animal studies and portraiture, the new range of Derwent Drawing brings colour to life.

Derwent Drawing is available individually, in a blister pack of six or in tins of 12 or 24 assorted colours.

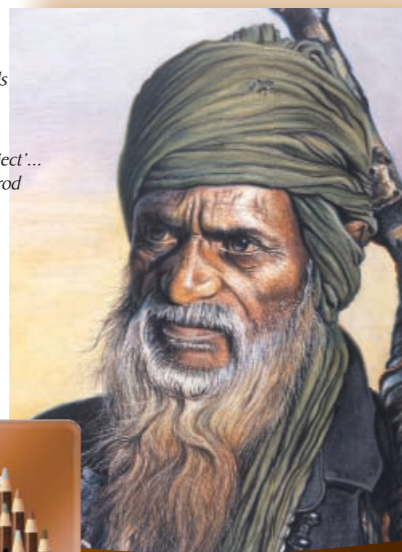

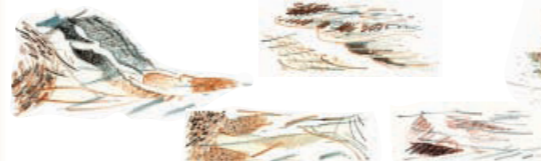

1 - Water Studies...
Colours used were; Solway Blue, Ink Blue, Smoke Violet, Mars Violet, Pale Cedar, Cool Grey and Chinese White.



Sand & Pebbles...
(covered by or reflected in water)
Colours used to achieve this were; Mars Orange, Warm Grey, Yellow Ochre

3 - Sky Techniques...
Combine in layers the following colours; Smoke Blue, Mars Violet and Ink Blue. Use a Derwent putty rubber to help create a smooth application/surface, then burnish with Chinese White.

2 - Rock Studies...
Wet rocks on the foreshore on a sunny day reflect many different colours. Use a Derwent Putty Rubber to help create textures and to clean out highlights. Use a Derwent Putty Rubber to clean reflected light out of shadows, then tint the resultant area with the appropriate colour. Use a scalpel to scratch out fine highlights and edges.
