Derwent Graphitint is an exciting new drawing pencil which combines the drama and creativity of the graphite medium with a hint of soft, subtle colour. Available in 24 fabulous colour tints, Graphitint can be used wet or dry to produce an amazing range of tinted graphite effects. Graphitint has been enthusiastically received by all who have tried it, and will appeal to any artist seeking a new medium that is highly creative and a little bit different.

Used dry like a conventional pencil, Graphitint produces soft tones of grey with just a suggestion of colour. Add water and the colours become far more vibrant. The colours can be lightened or removed with a soft eraser or by lifting out with a brush and clean water. Colour tints range from soft greys, blues and greens to glowing russets, plums and browns. All can be mixed and blended to produce even more subtle colour variations.

Stylishly finished in graphite and silver, Derwent Graphitint works well with all other Derwent media. It is available individually, in a blister pack of 6 or in assorted tins of 12 and 24.

1. Using Autumn Brown put down a wash about a third of the way along then before it dries add Meadow jet into jet over lapping the colours. Once dry use a rubber to pull out highlights.
2. Then once dry use Autumn Brown dry to draw details on the seaweed.

1. First add Sage as a wash background colour.
2. Then using Ocean Blue start to detail the scales as a wash.
3. Finish with Dark Indigo using wet and dry techniques.



1. First apply Ocean blue and Aubergine dry onto the surface
2. Then wash through using clean water, once dry use a rubber to pull out detail.
3. Go back to Ocean blue and draw over the wash for your detail.
