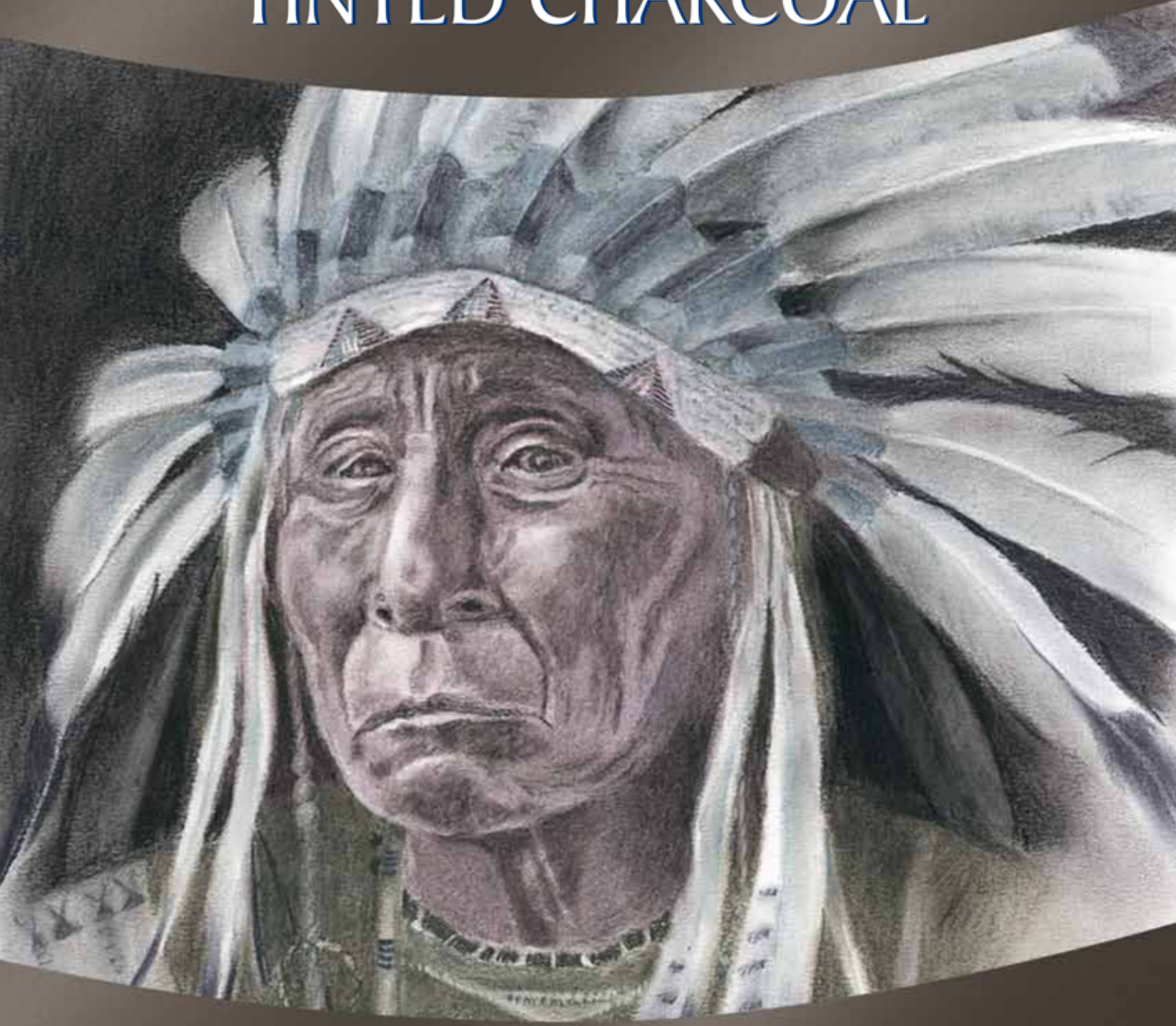

- Ideal for life drawings and portraiture, still life and landscape scenes

Fixing

Often the choice of whether to fix a drawing or not is down to personal preference. If you do want to use a fixative choose a good quality drawing fixative, test a small area first to make sure it is flowing correctly and then spray finely and evenly over the drawing. To protect the drawing whilst working on it you can always cover it with tissue paper, once the drawing is complete it can be sent straight away to be framed without being fixed.



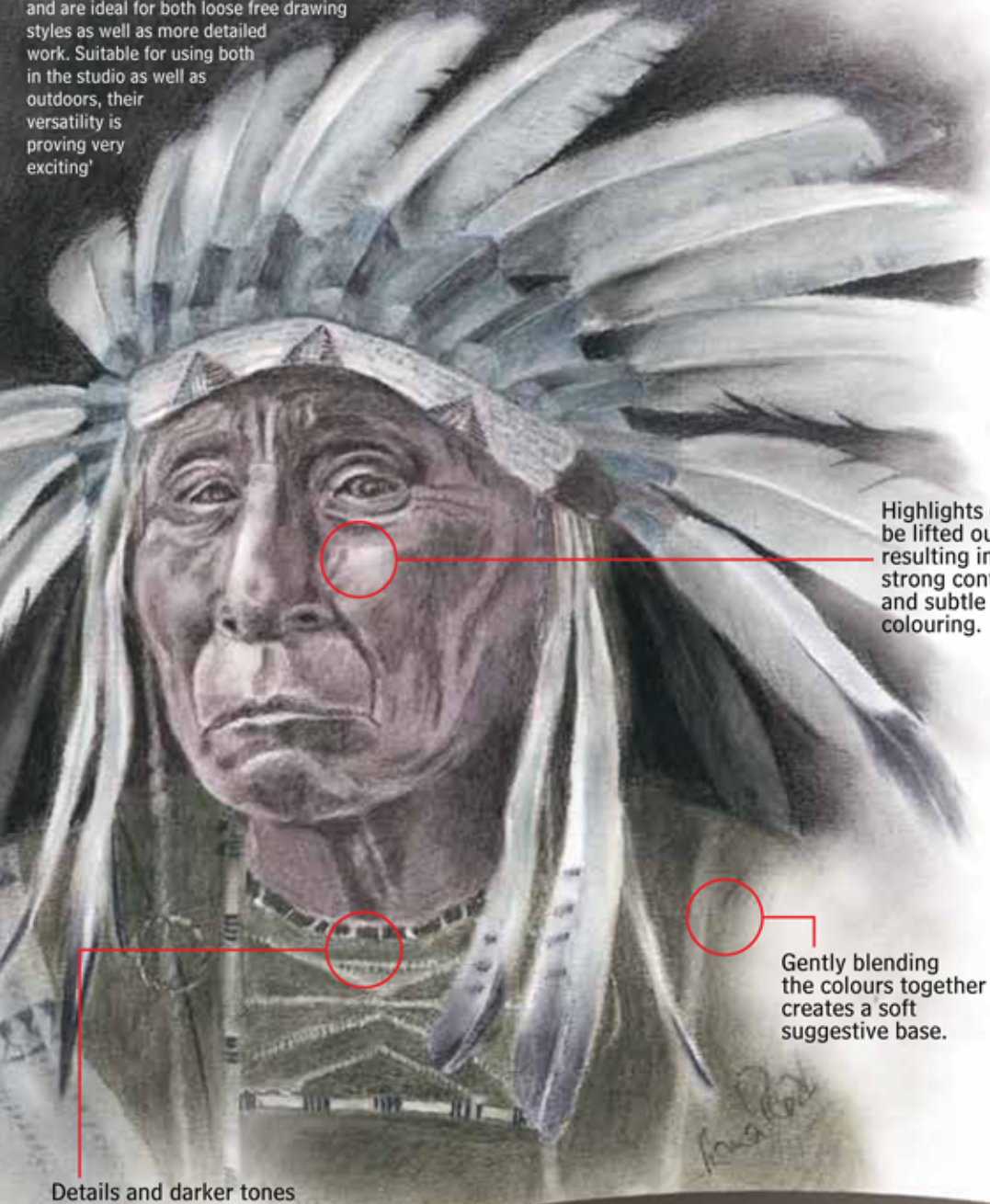
